



RENUNCIATION OF CITIZENSHIP

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The attached Renunciation form should be read carefully before it is completed.
2. The form must be completed in duplicate and signed before a Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of Affidavits, Notary Public or an Official of similar standing.
3. Evidence of the applicant's place and date of birth must be submitted, i.e. certified copy of Birth Certificate. In the case where the applicant is a Grenadian citizen pursuant to Section 97 of the Constitution of Grenada, i.e. born outside of Grenada after 7th February, 1974, to a Grenadian parent(s), evidence of the parent's place and date of birth must be submitted, i.e. a certified copy of the parent's Birth Certificate. If no name appears on the Birth Certificate in either case, a certified copy of the Baptismal Certificate or Original Affidavit must be submitted.
4. In the case of a married person, a certified copy of the Marriage Certificate must be submitted.
5. The citizenship certificate (if one was obtained) must be submitted.
6. Two (2) passport sized photographs must be submitted.
7. EC\$250.00 plus EC\$5.10 transaction fee (**US\$93.90**) must be submitted in a Bank Draft or Money Order or British Postal Order made payable to the **Government of Grenada**.

9. If the applicant is outside of Grenada, he/she may submit the above mentioned documentation through the respective Embassy, High Commission or Consulate in the country where he/she is located.

In the United States of America, the application must include a money order made payable to the **Embassy of Grenada** in the amount of **US\$18.00** to cover shipping by courier to Grenada. The address in the USA is:
